Long Pond, PA (July 7, 2009): Following a strong showing in his Nationwide Series debut at New Hampshire Motorspeedway, Mattioli feeling confident about returning to the ARCA RE/MAX circuit, in Saturday's ARCA RE/MAX Prairie Meadows 200, at Iowa Speedway.

Due to inclement weather and problems with his seat, Chase was only able to get eight laps under his belt, prior to the Nationwide Series, Camping World RV Sales 200. However, even with these limitations Chase was still able to drive the NO. 7 Qik Joe/JoinAPS.Com Chevrolet to an admirable 32nd place finish, after starting in the 42nd position. More importantly, Chase avoided trouble while gaining all important experience. En route to an overall successful debut, he earned the respect of veteran drivers, displayed when Sprint Cup driver, and eventual winner of Saturday's race, Kyle Busch, gave him a thumb's up as he passed him.

Although this is Chase's first ARCA RE/MAX race at Iowa Speedway, Mattioli is not stranger to the track, having spent last weekend gaining about 100 laps of necessary seat time.

"Loudon was great for me because it allowed me to watch how drivers like Kyle Busch and Carl Edwards, remained patient throughout the race and adjusted their lines as the track conditions worsened" Mattioli said. "This week at Iowa, I plan to be patient, drive a safe and smart race early on, and then start picking off the other car's one by one while making my push for the win" Mattioli concluded.

Following this weeks ARCA RE/MAX Prairie Meadows 200, at Iowa Speedway, Chase will be go co-driving a car in the July 18th, KONI Grand Am Series race at Barber Motorsports Park, before returning to Long Pond, to compete in the Pennsylvania ARCA 200, at Pocono Raceway.
